Mohit's inspiration to learn playin the piano – at the age of seven – wer the Hindi film songs he heard his grandmother's neighbour play on th keyboard.

"My plano teacher - (late) loseph Thomas with whom I trained for 10 years - said he doesn't teach Hindi film songs, so I got immersed in western classical music. Yet the yen layl Hindi songs on the plano remained," says Mohit, who has been playing the plano for 23 years. Mohit believes that the plano is the king of all instruments. "One can play one note at a time on a volin, flute or gultar but on the plano, one can play as many as one's fingers can. The plano is the only instrument which can be both an accompanying instrument and a solo one. Students taking music exams also need a plano player with them."
